DESCRIPTION

APPLE (HONEY CRISP): 5-GAL - FRUIT COLOUR: YELLOW/GOLDFLESH MEDIUM IN SIZE, SMOOTH, SWEET OR ACIDIC: HEAVY FLOWERING : MID LATE SEASON : PARTIALLY SELF-FERTILE : VIGOUR: AVERAGE GROWTH -GARDENING SKILL: EASY FRUIT BEARING ATTRACTIVE BLOSSOM. Grows 8-15' tall

FUJI

PEACH (RELIENCE): 5-GAL- Our hardiest peach tree. This tree produces a heavy crop of fruit as far north as Canada, even after frigid winters. Perfect for northern fruit gardens! Fruit is medium-to-large with a sweet, peachy flavor. Features a flush of pink flowers in spring. Cold-hardy. Freestone. Ripens in July. Self-pollinating 12-15'tall.

PEAR (RED ANJOU): 5GAL - DARK RED TO CRIMSON IN COLOR; FIRM AND DENSE JUICY WHEN RIPE: RED ANJOU IS AN AROMATIC PEAR WITH A PLEASANT SWEET FLAVOR AND HINT OF CITRUS; VERY REFRESHING RED ANJOU PEAR ARE GREAT EATEN FRESH OUT OF HAND IN SALADS AND BROILED OR POACHED.

APRICOT (MOORPARK) 5-GAL VERY LARGE, SWEET, JUICY DEEP ORANGE FLESH. SMOOTH GOLDEN-YELLOW SKIN WITH ORANGE-RED BLUSH. EXCELLENT FOR FRESH EATING, CANNING OR DRYING. LONG RIPENING PERIOD, EARLY JULY TO LATE AUGUST. SELF-FERTILE.

PLUMS (EARLY-ITALIAN): 5 GAL- THE ITALIAN PLUM OR PRUNE TREE ALSO CALLED "FELLENBERG" GROWS TO 15 TO 20' HIGH WITH A SLIGHTLY LARGER SPREAD. BECAUSE THEY ARE LATE BLOOMERS AND HAVE A LONG GROWING SEASON, ITALIAN PLUM TREES DO BEST WHEN PLANTED IN AREAS WITH A LATER FROST DATE. THEY ALSO RESPOND WELL IN AREAS WITH COLD, WET SPRINGS, THE PINK OR WHITE BLOSSOMS APPEAR IN MID SPRING.

QUAKING ASPEN 1-GAL IS NATIVE TO IDAHO - WILLOW FAMILY (Salicaceae): THIS IS A NATIVE TREE 5-30 m HIGH 15 m, WITH A ROUNDED CROW; LATERAL ROOT MAY EXTEND OVER 30 METERS AND VERTICAL SINKER ROOTS FROM THE LATERALS MAY EXTEND DOWNWARD FOR NEARLY 3M; BARK TYPICALLY SMOOTH, GREENISH-WHITE TO GREY-WHITE, OFTEN THIN AND PEELING, BECOMING THICKER AND FURROWED WITH AGE.

CHOKO CHERRY: 2-3' A LARGE, SUCKERING SHRUB OR SMALL TREE NATIVE ACROSS THE UNITED STATES WHICH MAY REACH A HEIGHT OF 15' ON A FAVORABLE SITE. PRODUCES ABUNDANT SMALL CHERRIES SUITABLE FOR JELLY OR FOR WILDLIFE.

REDOSIER DOGWOOD: 2-3' DOGWOOD FAMILY (CORNACEAE) REDOSIER DOGWOOD IS A WOODY DECIDUOUS SHRUB GENERALLY 1.4-6 m (4.6-20 ft) tall. THE BARK AND TWIGS ARE REDDISH TO PURPLE THE BARK AND TWIGS ARE REDDISH TO PURPLE AND FAIRLY SMOOTH FROM AUTUMN TO LATE SPRING:

SIBERIAN PEA SHRUB: 2-3' Siberian pea shrub (also known as caragana) is a shrub or small tree that can grow up to 18 feet tall. It has yellow flowers in the tubular shape characteristic of plants in the pea family and produces abundant seedpods. It can compete with native shrubs in forest and savanna environments and overtake grassland areas and convert them to shrublands..

COMMON PURPLE LILAC: GAL - SYRINGA VULGARIS IS A LARGE DECIDUOUS SHRUB OR MULTISTEMMED SMALL TREE, GROWING 6-7 m (20-30') HIGH, PRODUCING SECONDARY SHOOTS FROM THE BASE OR ROOTS, WITH STEM DIAMETERS UP TO 20CM (8IN), WHICH IN THE COURSE OF DECADES MAY PRODUCE A SMALL COLONIAL THICKET.

NANKING CHERRY: 2-3' IS A DECIDUOUS SHRUB THAT GROWS 8- 10' IN HEIGHT, WITH FLOWERS THAT ARE WHITE OR PINK IN A SCARLET CALYX, IN THE SPRING. THE FRUIT IS A SWEET BUT SLIGHTLY TART CHERRY RIPE IN EARLY SUMMER. IT PREFERS FULL SUN AND GROWS NATURALLY IN A VARIETY OF SOILS. DROUGHT RESISTANT AND COLD RESISTANT.

AUTUMN BLAZE MAPLE: 5-GAL' The autumn blaze maple tree is a hybrid of the red maple tree and the silver maple tree, both native to North America. Their branch pattern is dense and ascending, and they sport a rounded or oval crown. Maturity comes quickly for the autumn blaze maple tree—they can grow as fast as three feet per year under the right conditions.

AMUR MAPLE: 2-3' A TALL SHRUB OR SMALL TREE NATIVE TO NORTHERN ASIA. POPULAR AS A SMALL, MULTISTEMMED SPECIEMEN TREE. OUTSTANDING BRIGHT REDDISH FALL COLORS ARE INFLUENCED BY SOIL CONDITIONS AND THE CULTIVAR GROWN. CAN GROW UP TO 30'

HYBRID POPLAR: 3-5' FAST GROWING AS MUCH AS 6 TO 10 FT A YEAR UNDER IRRIGATED CONDITIONS. DISCOVERED APPROXIMATELY 40 YEARS AGO, THIS VARIETY IS ESPECIALLY WELL ADAPTED TO CONDITIONS IN IDAHO.

GREEN ASH: 2-3' A HARDY, NATIVE, DROUGHT AND ALKALI RESISTANT MEDIUM TO LARGE TREE. SINCE THE ONSET OF DUTCH ELM DISEASE, GREEN ASH HAS BEEN OVER-PLANTED IN URBAN AND CONSERVATION SETTINGS AS A REPLACEMENT FOR AMERICAN ELM. THE LARGEST TREE IN NORTH DAKOTA IS 69' TALL WITH A CANOPY SPREAD OF 74 FEET.

WESTERN SAND CHERRY: 2-3' Type and size – Shrub, 2-6 feet high and across Hardiness zone – 3-6 Exposure– Full sun (commercial) to part shade (home garden) Soil– Sandy loam to clay loam, pH 4.5-7.5 Drainage– Moderate to well drained. **Popular for landscaping**

GOLDEN WILLOW: 3-4' IS MEDIUM-SIZED, FAST GROWING TREE THAT ATTAINS HEIGHTS OF 40-50 FEET AT MATURITY. THIS WILLOW GROWS WELL ON THE PALOUSE AND ON MOIST SITES BUT HAS A WIDE ADAPTABILITY TO SOIL AND MOISTURE CONDITIONS. IT SHOULD BE WATERED IF USED IN DRYLAND PLANTINGS.

COL. BLUE / GREEN SPRUCE: GAL: THEY CAN GROW UNUSUALLY SLOWLY THE FIRST 1-3 YEARS AFTER PLANTING, BUT HAS A MEDIUM GROWTH RATE AFTER THAT. ITS CROWN IS VERY DENSE WITH ATTRACTIVE PYRAMIDAL FORM REACHING HEIGHTS OF 50-60FT. IT MAKES AN EXCELLENT WINDBREAK SPECIES IN MOST REGIONS OF THE STATE AND TRAPS AND HOLDS SNOW WELL.

AUSTRIAN PINE : GAL: HAS A FAST RATE OF GROWTH, GROWING 18-24' INCHES A YEAR ONCE ESTABLISHED, EVENTUALLY ACHIEVING HEIGHTS OF 40-80- FT. IT HAS A DENSE, DARK GREEN CROWN. IT HOLDS ITS LOWER BRANCHES VERY WELL, AND IS AN EXCELLENT TREE WITH IRRIGATION. INTERMOUNTAIN NATIVE UPRIGHT EVERGREEN GROWS TO 15-25' HIGH. MODERATELY FAST
